DELIVERING IMPACT AND CHANGE LOCALLY WITH RESIDENTS

We are working with residents to deliver improvements to community infrastructure across Westdene & Hove Park, from new parks and play areas, to refurbishing public toilets and installing new pedestrian crossings where needed.

Samer BAGAEEN, Emma **HOGAN** and Ivan LYONS want to continue improving community infrasructure across Westdene & Hove Park ward.

Conservative Councillors have secured £1 million funding for major improvements to Hove Park, including: Path widening (£35,000); Toilet block refurbishment and a new tennis pavilion (£300.000):

Basketball court resurfacing (£75,000); New equipment for the children's plauaround (£250,000); Outdoor fitness aum trail (£70,000); and a share of £280.000 for new trees.

We have worked with residents to secure road safety improvements across the ward, including the junction of Hove Park Road and Shirley Drive, which is now in procurement. We are now working with residents to improve the safety at neighbouring junctions.

We have worked with residents and developers to divert construction traffic away from guiet residential streets, including Woodland Drive and Goldstone Crescent and we are consistently monitoring for compliance.

Following a visit with residents to the Hove Recucling Centre, we arranged for acoustic fencing and additional safetu measures in and around the tip to protect the amenity for residents on Old Shoreham Road and Aldrington Avenue.

If elected we will continue our proactive work on behalf of residents and look after the interests of Westdene & Hove Park residents at the City Council.
